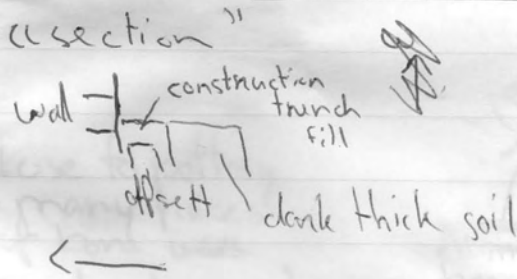
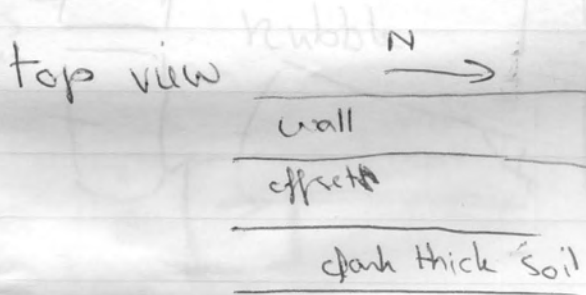


(121) 13-07-08 rubble burn

- ~~for~~ digging construction trench of wall north of doorstep:
from doorpost north: ~~bits~~ 3 found bits of charcoal (about $\frac{1}{2}$ cm \times $\frac{1}{2}$ cm) at the 3rd wall stone from doorpost
- reddish loose rubblely ~~st~~ deposit in construction trench
- found a roofslab at 5th stone
- ~~a~~ offset exposed, different ~~feature~~ deposit composed of finer, thicker, darker soil

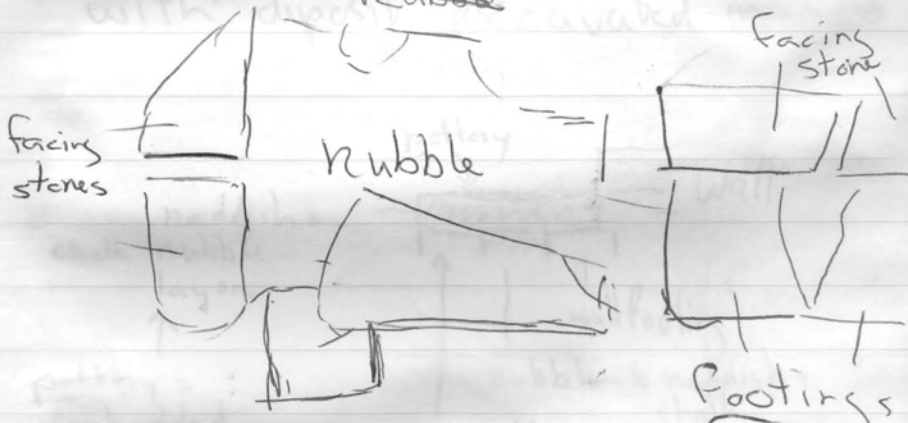

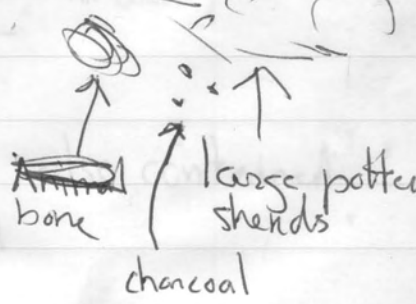

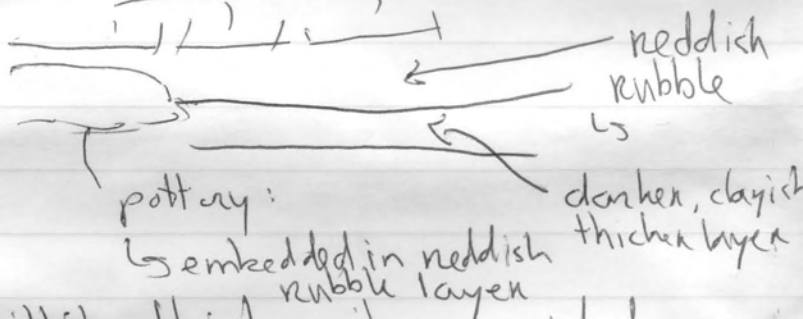

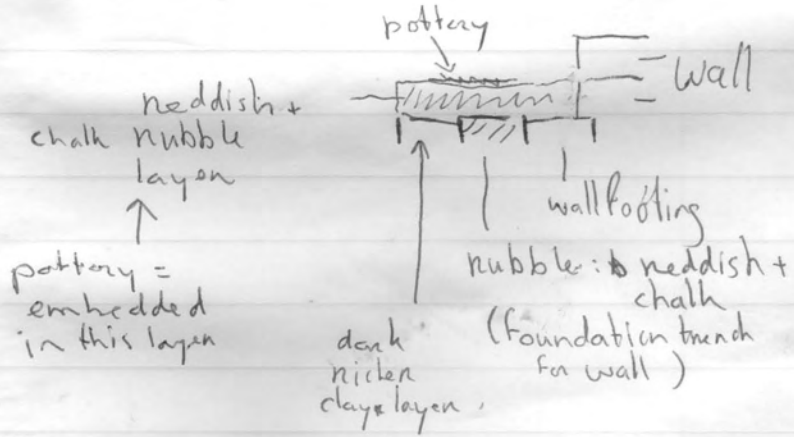
