

- TINY RUBBLE IN MUCH OF SOIL.
- SMALL BITS OF TILE STREWN ABOUT
- PLASTER PATCHES, UNRECOVERABLE & DISCRIMINATED.
- TINY SMALL BITS OF RECOVERABLE PLASTER w/ PAINT (OFTEN WHITE), & NEVER IN LARGE SECTIONS.

- BIT OF PLASTER POSSIBLY STILL ON WALL POSSIBLE
 - FLOOR SURFACE OF SMALL AREA OF ROCK, BENEATH WHICH IS MORE RUBBLE & PLASTER

PLASTER - NW CORNER

- EXPANDED EXCAV AROUND PRIOR AREA OF IP3, INTO IP4.
- IP4 PREDOMINATELY RED & WHITE, & SOME PIECES SHOW INTERSECTION OF TWO COLORS ALSO IN F
- IN FAR NW CORNER, LARGER PIECES OF MARMELADE-PLASTER, w/ BITS (OBSERVED BUT SCARCELY REMOVED) FADING FROM

THE DARK MARMELADE INTO A CREAMY
WHITE. THE SPACE BTWN THE DARKEST
YELLOW & BRIGHTEST CREAM IS ABOUT
 $1\frac{1}{2}$ INCH.
