XV med.~~, good German hand, headings in red, capitals in alternate red and blue. On ff. 7, 65, 65^b initials with fine red flourishing (gold silver and green are used). +⁶ (1 pasted down) a-g⁸ (wants g⁸ blank), aa⁸ (wants ^{1,2} ~~ff~~), bb⁶ (wants ~~bb~~ ⁴⁻⁶), one quardleaf pasted down. Original stamped vellum over oak boards to 3 bands (~~back~~ ^{re-backed} damaged); two embossed clasps, one inscribed **IRAT** (?); for the stamps see appendix.

(f. 65^b Text) Fiddis homo electus homo est... immunde autem anime nil audeas de Deo dicere. The so-called Sextus Pythagoreus; this copy is cited as U in the edition of J. Gildemeister, Sexti sententiarum recensiones, Bonn 1873. There is no colophon, and at the foot of 73^b a pencilled query (contemporary): An sit hic finis huius libri; but the text is complete. There is no clue to the contents of the lost ff. 63, 64; 74-76 were very likely blank.

From Lichtenhof, a house of the Prethren of the Common Life in Brühl, a suburb of Hildesheim: On f. 77 is an erased inscr. (contemporary): Liber congregationis fratrum sive domus | Horti luminum beate Marie virginis in | Brulone Hildensemensi, and on ^{the top of} f. 2 another: Liber presbiterorum et clericorum... | ... dictum L... beate Marie virginis ... | densum in Brulone. It does not appear among the books recorded in R. Doebner's edn. of the Annalen und Akten of the house in the Quellen und Darstellungen zur Geschichte Niedersachsens vol. IX, 1903. On f. 3 is another erased inscr., apparently in a XVIIIth cent. foreign hand, ending ... Catalogo ~~de~~ inscriptus ~~no.~~ No. 56 (?), with a large C.
