Vellum, 15 $\frac{1}{4}$ x 11 $\frac{1}{4}$ in., 114 ff (out of 116; 49 and 116 lost), double columns, 40 lines to a page. X^{cent.} round and upright English hand, with the first two quires a xv^{cent.} replacement imitating the original hand. Headings in red, fine initials and capitals in red, blue, or green. In the replacement, initials of burnished gold on particoloured grounds of blue and purple diapered with white dots, and with engraved edges. There are evident traces of the damp which, no doubt, destroyed the earlier leaves.
