Written in three volumes (50 Psalms in each) by several small hands of the late x^{cent.}, with red headings, capitals and small initials in red, blue, or green, the latter with conventional foliage filling. The various divisions have handsome initials in burnished gold, outlined in black, with filling of conventional foliage, etc. in red, blue, and green.
