

3062 SUMMARIUM BIBLICUM

Vellum, a roll of 4 membranes (9 ft 8½ in. x 6½ in.), single column. Fine and early 15th cent. English hand, with headings and capitals in red, the capitals in the text touched with red, and small blue initials with conventional foliage filling and flourishing in red.

Summaria compilatio metrificata docens quid communius et utilius continetur in unoquoque capitulo totius biblie. Unde quodlibet verbum hic inscriptum tenet sententiam unius capituli ut sequitur. Sex. prohibet. peccavi. Abel. Inok. archa fit. intrant. (Gen. i-vii) - Flebunt. ad cenam. surgent. sponsam. venio iam. (Apo. xviii-xxii). Finis huius operis. This summary, often printed, is ascribed to Alexander de Villa Dei.
